FREDDIE MERCURY QUEEN MICROPHONE

Freddie used a Shure 565 microphone during his performances. He preferred this model for live music.

JOHN LENNON GLASSES

Iconic round spectacles owned and worn by John Lennon.

AMY WINEHOUSE WHITE TANK TOP

The late Amy Winehouse was one of the most important artists of the 21st century. Amy wore this humble white top both on and off stage.

DAVID BOWIE COSTUME

One of the most significant pieces in the entire Hard Rock collection. This was the last time Bowie performed as his iconic Ziggy Stardust alter ego.

JIMI HENDRIX VELVET FLARE TROUSERS

The true Icon of the '60s fashion wore these absolutely amazing velvet pants on stage while performing at the BBC Playhouse Theatre in London in 1967.

ELTON JOHN STAGE OUTFIT

Elton wore this stage outfit in 1986 as a tribute to the outfit he wore during his iconic U.S. debut gig at the Troubadour in Los Angeles in 1970. The costume was designed by Bob Mackie. Elton John has sold more than 250 million records, making him one of the most successful artists of all time.

PAUL MCCARTNEY MICROPHONE

This Shure Unisphere was used during his 2022 Driving World Tour rehearsals.

ED SHEERAN COSTUME

He wore this outfit in the video for his 2014 hit "Thinking Out Loud".

OZZY OSBOURNE ROBE

The heavy metal icon owned and wore this stylish robe.
